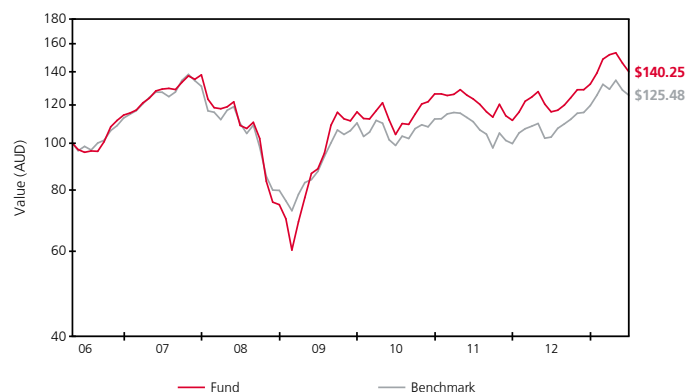

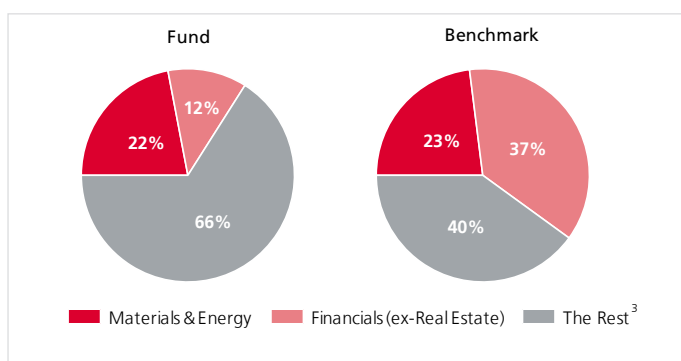
## Value of AUD 100 invested at public launch
